

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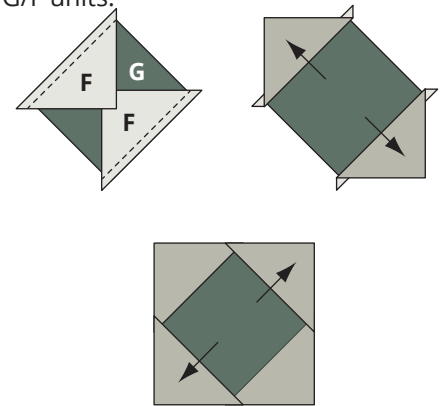
# DIAMOND ROW QUILT PATTERN

|    | Net Stella-370 White             | 2 yards                             | Cut 8 strips, 2 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " x lof (length of fabric). Trim each strip to 60 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> ". From the remaining fabric, cut sixty-four <b>A</b> squares, 3 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 3 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> ".  |
|    | Net Stella-370 Grey              | 1 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> yards | Cut 2 strips, 11" x wof (width of fabric). Sub-cut nine <b>B</b> rectangles, 11" x 5" and six <b>C</b> rectangles, 11" x 2 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> ". Cut one strip, 5 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " x wof. Sub-cut six <b>D</b> rectangles, 5 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " x 5", and four <b>E</b> rectangles, 5 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " x 2 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> ". Cut 3 strips, 3 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " x wof. Sub-cut thirty-two squares, 3 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " x 3 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> ". Cut each square once diagonally to create sixty-four <b>F</b> half square triangles (HSTs).  |

Aligning the template arrows with the vertical direction of the fabric print, cut twelve template <b>G</b> squares, four template <b>H</b> triangles, and four template <b>H-reversed</b> triangles from the remaining yardage.  |
|  | Net Stella-370 Grass             | 1/2 yard                            | Cut 1 strip, 15 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x wof (width of fabric). Sub-cut three <b>I</b> rectangles, 15 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 6 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> ".  |
|  | Begonias Stella-554 Multi        | 1/2 yard                            | Cut 1 strip, 15 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x wof (width of fabric). Sub-cut five <b>I</b> rectangles, 15 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 6 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> ".   |
|  | Tropical Forest Stella-553 Green | 1/2 yard each                       | From <i>each</i> fabric, cut 1 strip, 15 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x wof. Sub-cut four <b>I</b> rectangles, 15 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 6 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> ".  |

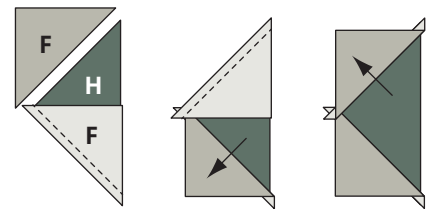
## Make the Pieced Units

1 Join the long edges of two F HSTs to opposite sides of a G square. Press the seam allowances away from the square. Repeat to join two F HSTs to the remaining two edges of the square. Press the seam allowances away from the square. Trim to 5" x 5". Make 12 G/F units.

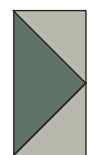

2 Join the long edge of one F HST to each short edge of the H triangle. Press the seams away from the H triangle. Trim to 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 5". Make 4 H and 4 H-reversed units.

3 Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each A square.

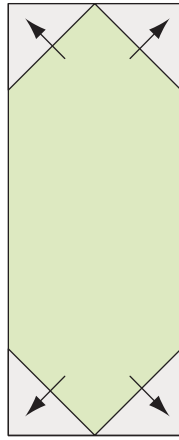
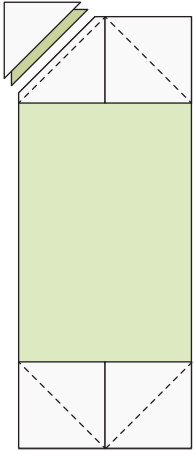
4 Place a marked A square on each corner of an I rectangle, right sides



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together. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim the excess fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press the seam allowances away from the rectangle. Make 16 I units.

## Assemble the Vertical Rows

1 Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric placement, arrange four I units in one vertical row, aligning the short ends. Join the units together along adjacent short ends to create a single row. Join a 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 60<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" white strip to each long edge of the row. Press the seams toward the strips. Make four I rows.

2 Arrange four G/F units, three B and two D rectangles as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Join the units and rectangles along adjacent edges to make a G/F row. Press the seams open. Make 3 G/F rows.

3 Arrange four H units, three C and two E rectangles as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Join the units and rectangles along adjacent short edges. Press the seams open to complete the

right side row. Repeat with the H-reversed units to make the left side row.

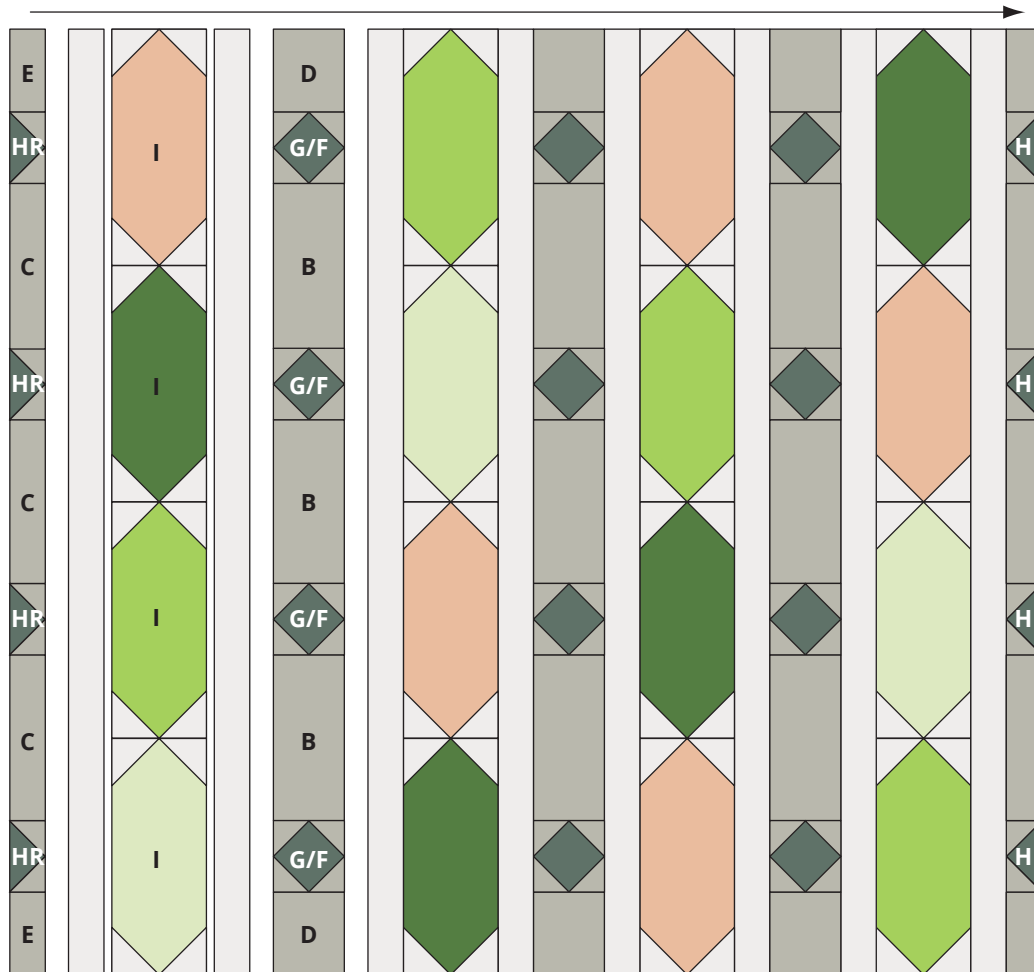
## Assembly

1 Arrange the I, G/F, right and left side rows as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Join the rows together along adjacent edges. Press the seams in one direction.

## Finishing

1 Remove the selvages, then cut the backing fabric into two equal lengths. Sew the two pieces together along one long edge, using a 1/2" seam allowance. Press the seam open.

2 Layer the quilt back, batting and quilt top. Quilt as desired. Stitch around the perimeter of the quilt, a scant 1/4" from the edge. Trim the excess fabric and batting. Use your favorite method to bind the quilt.
