## Finished Quilt Size: 54" x 66"

Be sure to read through instructions before beginning. Cutting instructions include $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Yardage is based on $42^{\prime \prime}$ of usable fabric width. All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) unless otherwise stated. Press all seams as you assemble your blocks. Border lengths given are exact measure ments. You may want to cut borders slightly longer to allow for variations in seams and mitering corners.

Fabric Requirements \& Cutting Instructions:
Fabric \#1: Twilight Orange 101.107.12.1 1-1/2 yards Cut (5) 4-1/2" x WOF strips.

Subcut into (18) 4-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.
Cut (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips.
Subcut into (24) 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.
Fabric \#2: Twilight Ivory 101.107.12.2 3/4 yard
Cut (7) 2-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips.
Subcut into (25) 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.
Fabric \#3: Twilight Black 101.107.12.3
1 yard
Cut (3) 4-1/2" x WOF strips.
Subcut into (4) 4-1/2" squares.
Subcut into (14) 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles.
Subcut into (12) 2-1/2" squares.
Cut (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.
Fabric \#4: Cat-Tastic Orange 101.107.11.2 $1 / 2$ yard
Cut (1) 10-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips.
Subcut into (2) 10-1/2" squares
Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips.
Subcut into (5) 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.
Fabric \#5: Cat-Tastic Black 101.107.11.1
3/4 yard
Cut (1) 10-1/2" x WOF strips.
Subcut into (3) 10-1/2" squares
Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips. Subcut into (10) 2-1/2" $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
Fabric \#6: Who's There Ivory 101.107.13.1 3/4 yard Cut (1) 10-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut into (3) 10-1/2" squares
Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips.
Subcut into (5) 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.

Fabric \#7: Who’s There Grey 101.107.13.2 3/4 yard Cut (1) 10-1/2" x WOF strips.

Subcut into (2) 10-1/2" squares
Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips.
Subcut into (10) 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.
Backing: Any Spooktacular Print
4 yards

## Piecing Instructions:

You will need to create 2 different rail blocks (5 blocks of each set):
First order is: Grey Who's There, Twilight Ivory, Cat-Tastic Black, Twilight Orange and Ivory Who's There.
Second order is: Cat-Tastic Black, Twilight Ivory, Grey Who's There, Twilight Orange and Cat-Tastic Orange.

Using diagram sew blocks together with $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ 10-1/2" strips.
*For example: Row one is sewn as:
Horizontal block / Twilight Orange strip / Cat-Tastic Block / Twilight Orange strip / Vertical block / Ivory Who's There.

To sew the horizontal strips which are sewn between each row - start with a $10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Twilight Ivory strip and sew to a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Twilight Black square on the short side. Repeat this process until you have 4 Twilight Ivory strips separated by 3 Twilight Black squares. Sew 4 of these combinations.

Referring to diagram - sew rows and sashing strips together.

For to side borders - start with a $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Twilight Orange rectangle and sew to a $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Twilight Black rectangles along the $4-1 / 2$ " side. Repeat this process until you have 5 Twilight Orange \& 4 Twilight Black strips sewn together. Sew one to each side.

For top and bottom borders - sew the same as the side borders except you will only have 4 Twilight Orange strips and 3 Twilight Black strips. Now sew a 4-1/2" Twilight Black square to each end of the borders. Sew one to the top and one to the bottom.

## Finishing

Layer quilt top, batting and backing piece, wrong sides of fabrics both toward batting and baste.
Hand quilt, machine quilt or tie as desired. Sew (6) $2-1 / 2$ " binding strips together into one continuous strip, iron in half lengthwise and sew to raw edge of quilt top.


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
