Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of FabricLOF = Length of Fabric

From the Green Chickens cut:

 $4 - 4 - 1/2'' \times LOF$ strips

 $5 - 4-1/2'' \times WOF \text{ strips}$

2 - 6 - 1/2'' squares

From the Aqua Chickens cut:

4 - 6 - 1/2" squares

From the Purple Chickens cut: 4 - 6 - 1/2" squares

From Pink Flowers cut:

8 - 6 - 1/2'' squares

1 – flower*

From Aqua Flowers cut: 4 - 6 - 1/2" squares

1 – flower*

From Yellow Flowers cut:

4 – 6-1/2" squares

1 - flower*

From Aqua Sm birds cut:

3 - 6 - 1/2'' squares

2 – mugs*

From Yellow Sm birds cut:

4 - 6 - 1/2'' squares

From Purple Sm birds cut:

 $2 - 6 - 1/2^{\text{#}}$ squares

6 - 2 - 1/2" x 42" strips for binding

 $1 - vase^*$

From Pink Tiles cut:

4 - 6 - 1/2'' squares

3 – 2" squares*

From Yellow Tiles cut:

4 - 6 - 1/2'' squares

From Aqua Tiles cut:

4 - 6 - 1/2'' squares $6 - 2'' \times 3''*$

From Yellow cut:

6 – 2" squares*

1 - Large Flower Set

From Orange cut: $4 - 2'' \times 3''^*$

1 – Large Flower Set

From Pink cut: 4 - 2'' squares*

1 – Large Flower Set From Purple cut:

 $4 - 2'' \times 3''*$

2 - Mug Handles

From Green cut:

1 - 6 - 1/2" square 3 – 3" squares*

3 – Stems*

From Aqua cut: 2 - Inner Mugs*

From Brown cut:

2 - Coffee*

From White cut:

2 – Steam Set*

From Backing cut:

 $2 - 55'' \times 42''$ strips. Sew them together to make one 55" x 67" backing

* See instructions to cut; each piece needs fusible web on the wrong side of the fabric before cutting

Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide unwashed fabric. Prewashing fabric may require additional yardage.

1 yard of Green Chickens (Y0949-18) 1/4 vard of Agua Chickens (Y0949-32) 1/4 yard of Purple Chickens (Y0949-26) 1/2 yard of Pink Flowers (Y0950-41) 1/4 yard of Agua Flowers (Y0950-32) 1/4 yard of Yellow Flowers (Y0950-8) 1/4 yard of Agua Sm Birds (Y0951-32) 1/4 vard of Yellow Sm Birds (Y0951-8) 3/4 yard of Purple Sm Birds (Y0951-26) 5/8 yard of Pink Tiles (Y0948-42) 3-1/4 Yards -Backing of Choice

1/4 yard of Yellow Tiles (Y0948-8) 1/4 vard of Agua Tiles (Y0948-33) Fat 1/8 of Yellow (Y1031-8) from Impressions Fat 1/8 of Orange (Y1031-36) from Impressions Fat 1/8 of Pink (Y1031-42) from Impressions Fat 1/8 of Purple (Y1031-27) from Impressions Fat 1/8 of Green (Y1031-19) from Impressions Fat 1/8 of Agua (Y1031-33) from Impressions Fat 1/8 of Brown (Y1031-14) from Impressions Fat 1/8 of White (Y1031-1) from Impressions 2 yards of Fusible Web

Directions

Fusible Applique Instructions:

- 1) Follow the manufacturer's instructions to trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. For coffee template, trace one as printed and one reverse.
- 2) Roughly cut out each shape outside the drawn lines. Press the templates to the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each shape on the drawn lines. Set aside.
- 3) Press fusible web to the wrong side of Green fabric. Cut three 1/2" wide strips on the bias from the Green fabric for the stems.
- 4) Press fusible web to the wrong side of the remaining Pink Tiles, Aqua Tiles, Yellow, Orange, Pink and Purple fabrics. Cut out the squares and rectangles as listed in the cutting directions with an *.
- 5) Refer to the quilt photo and fuse one small square or rectangle to each 6-1/2" square as shown. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a satin or buttonhole stitch.
- 6) Press one small flower to the center of one large flower (from one of the Large Flower sets) as shown in the quilt photo. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a satin or buttonhole stitch.
- 7) Put the two halves of one Large Flower set, back together, right sides together. Sew around the edges of the flower set, using a 1/4" seam allowance. Clip the curved edges of the sewn flower set and carefully slit the back flower (the one without the small flower) to turn the large flower right side out. Repeat to make the other two large flowers. You will attach these to the finished quilt.

Quilt Top Assembly Instructions:

- 8) Refer to the quilt photo for block placement to sew together the assorted 6-1/2" squares to make one 36-1/2" x 48-1/2" quilt top.
- 9) Sew one 2" x 48-1/2" Pink Tiles strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2" x 39-1/2" Pink Tiles strip to the top and bottom of the guilt top.
- 10) Position and press the mugs, vase, steam and stems to the quilt top as shown. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a satin or buttonhole stitch.
- 11) Sew four 4-1/2"x LOF strips end to end; recut into two 4-1/2 x 51-1/2" strips. Sew to each side of the quilt top. Sew five 4-1/2 x WOF strips end to end; recut into two 4-1/2 x 47-1/2" strips. Sew to the top and bottom of the guilt top
- 12) Layer. quilt and bind as desired.
- 13) Position the three large flowers on the quilt top as shown with the side of the flower with the slit against the quilt. Stitch around the smaller flower through all the layers to sew the flowers to the quilt top.
