## Painted Summer

## "Impressionist Garden Quilt"

Finished Block Size: 16" x 16"
Finished Quilt Size: 7412" x 90½"

- Yardages are based on 40 " fabric width.



## Materials

$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Coral Hummingbird (1LEB1) for blocks
$5 / 8$ yd. Yellow Hummingbird (1LEB2) for blocks
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Green Hummingbird (1LEB3) for blocks
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Blue Hummingbird (1LEB4) for blocks
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Peach Peony (2LEB1) for blocks
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Yellow Peony (2LEB2) for blocks
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Light Blue Peony (2LEB3) for blocks
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Coral Butterfly (3LEB1) for blocks
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Yellow Butterfly (3LEB2) for blocks
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Orange Daisy (4LEB1) for blocks
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Yellow Daisy (4LEB2) for blocks
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Green Daisy (4LEB3) for blocks
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Orange Small Floral (5LEB1) for blocks
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Yellow Small Floral (5LEB2) for blocks
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Blue Small Floral (5LEB3) for blocks
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Green Berries (6LEB1) for blocks
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Blue Berries (6LEB2) for blocks
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Pink/Green Hydrangea (7LEB1) for blocks
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Peach/Yellow Hydrangea (7LEB2) for blocks
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. Peach/Blue Hydrangea (7LEB3) for blocks
$1 / 2 \mathrm{yd}$. Green Stripes (8LEB3) for inner border
/7/ yd. Blue Stripes (8LEB4) for binding
$5 \% / 8 \mathrm{yds}$. for backing (vertical seam)

## Cutting

Cut strips across width of fabric, unless otherwise instructed. Important Note: Cut Block Pieces first, as listed below. Leftovers from those prints can then be used for the Outer Border Pieces.

## Block Pieces

From each $5 / 8$ d . piece of fabric ( 20 different prints), cut:

- 1 square, $16^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$
- 1 circle, $12^{1 ⁄ 2}$ " diameter (Note: You will need to make a durable paper or cardboard template of the circle. The $12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ diameter includes $1 / 4$ " seam allowance all around. If you plan to use a fusible appliqué method for your blocks, make a 12 " diameter template instead of $12^{1 / 2}$ ". Your template can be drawn using a compass. Alternately, you can trace around a suitably sized dinner plate to make your template.)


## Outer Border Pieces

From leftovers of the $5 / 8 \mathrm{y}$ d. pieces of fabric (20 different prints), cut a total of:

- 148 rectangles, $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2$ ", for pieced border
- 4 squares, $41 / 2$ " x $41 / 2$ ", for border corners


## Inner Border and Binding Strips

From Green Stripes, cut:

- 8 strips, $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 ", for inner border

From Blue Stripes, cut:

- 9 strips, $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40$ ", for double-fold binding


## Assembly

All seams $1 / 4$ ". Press seams in direction of arrows unless otherwise instructed. Refer to photograph for fabric placement.

1. Using your favorite appliqué technique, sew one assorted print $121 / 2$ circle to one assorted print $161 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square. Repeat to make a total of 20 appliqué blocks.


Make 20.

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2. Sew 4 blocks together in a row as shown. Repeat to make a total of 5 rows. Press seams in opposite directions from row to row.


Make 5.
3. Sew rows together as shown. Press seams in one direction.


Borders

1. Sew the 8 inner border strips together, end-to-end, to make one long strip. Press seams open.
2. From the long strip, cut 2 strips $801 / 2$ " long, and cut 2 strips $661 / 2$ " long.
3. Sew the $801 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ inner border strips to the sides of the quilt top. Press seams toward inner borders.
4. Sew the $661 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ inner border strips to the top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward inner borders.
5. Sew 41 assorted print $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2$ " rectangles together with long sides matching, as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram at right. Repeat to make a total of 2 outer borders (sides).
6. Sew 33 assorted print $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles together with long sides matching. Repeat to make a total of 2 outer borders (top and bottom).
7. Sew one assorted print $4 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square to each side of both outer border strips made in Step 6.
8. Sew outer border strips (made in Step 5) to sides of quilt. Press seams toward inner borders.
9. Sew outer border strips (made in Step 7) to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward inner borders.

## Finishing

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.
