Finished Quilt Size: 67" x 85"

Finished Block Sizes: 18" square, 12" square, 9" square, 6" square

#### Supplies:

- A. 13/8y: G8555-55S-Charcoal silver / G8555-22G-Ivory Gold
- B. 13/4y: N7504-76S-Pewter Silver / N7505-194G-Robins Egg Gold
- C. 15/8y: G8555-113S-Frost Silver/ G8555-450G-Spa Gold
- D. 17/8y: G8555-3S-White Silver / G8555-3G-White Gold
- E. 1/4y: N7506-542S-Dove Silver / N7506-134G-Parchment Gold
- F. 3/4y: N7507-447S-Sweetpea Silver / N7507-41G-Aqua Gold
- G. 11/4y: N7505-326a-Zinnia Silver / N7504-134G-Parchment Gold
- H. 3/8y: N7508-55S-Charcoal Silver / N7508-291G-Olivia Gold
- I. 5/8y N7507-542S-Dove Silver / N7507-291G-Olivia Gold, cut into 2 1/4" strips. Piece strips to make a continuous binding strip.

73" x 91" piece of backing fabric (5 1/8y)

73" x 91" piece of batting

Basic sewing supplies

#### **Cutting Instructions:**

- 1. From fabric A, cut for
- a. star blocks

18" blocks – cut widthwise, (1) 7 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (5) 7 1/4" x 7 1/4" squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 20 quarter triangles.

12" blocks – cut widthwise, (1) 5 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (5) 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 20 quarter triangles.

9" blocks –cut widthwise, (2) 4 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (12) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 48 quarter triangles.

6" blocks – cut widthwise,(2) 3 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (16) 3 1/4" x 3 1/4" squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 64 quarter triangles.

#### b. inner border #1

Cut widthwise, (7) 2" x 42". Piece strips and sub-cut (2) 2" x 57 1/2" and (2) 2" x 72 1/2" strips.

- 2. From fabric B, cut for
- a. star blocks

18" blocks -

Widthwise, (1) 6 1/2" x 42". Sub-cut (2) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.

Widthwise, (1) 7 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (4) 7 1/4" x 7 1/4" squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 16 quarter triangles.

12" blocks -

Widthwise, (1) 5 1/4" x 42"). Sub-cut (2) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" and (4) 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" squares. Cut 5 1/4" squares diagonally twice to yield 16 quarter triangles.

9" blocks -

Widthwise, (1) 4 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (2) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" and (4) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares. Cut 4 1/4" squares diagonally twice to yield 16 quarter triangles.

b. outer border

Widthwise, (8) 4 1/2" x 42". Piece strips and sub-cut (2) 4 1/2" x 67 1/2" and (2) 4 1/2" x 77 1/2" strips.

- 3. From fabric C, cut for
- a. star blocks

18" blocks -

Widthwise, (2) 6 1/2" x 42". Sub-cut (12) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.

Widthwise, (1)  $7 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 42". Sub-cut (3)  $7 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 12 quarter triangles.

12" blocks -

Widthwise, (2) 4 1/2" x 42". Sub-cut (12) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.

Widthwise, (1) 5 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (3) 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 12 quarter triangles.

9" blocks -

Widthwise, (2) 3 1/2" x 42". Sub-cut (16) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.

Widthwise, (1) 4 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (4) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 16 quarter triangles.

6" blocks -

Widthwise, (1) 2 1/2" x 42". Sub-cut (12) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.

Widthwise, (1) 3 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (3) 3 1/4" x 3 1/4" squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 12 quarter triangles.

- 4. From fabric D, cut for
- a. star blocks

18" blocks -

Widthwise, (2) 6 1/2" x 42". Sub-cut (8) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.

Widthwise,(1) 7 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (2) 7 1/4" x 7 1/4") squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 8 quarter triangles.

12" blocks -

Widthwise, (1) 4 1/2" x 42". Sub-cut 8 (4 1/2" x 4 1/2") squares.

Widthwise, (1) 5 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (2) 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 8 quarter triangles.

9" blocks -

Widthwise, (3) 3 1/2" x 42". Sub-cut (32) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.

Widthwise, (1) 4 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (8) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 32 quarter triangles.

6" blocks -

Widthwise, (4) 2 1/2" x 42". Sub-cut (52) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.

Widthwise, (2) 3 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (13) 3 1/4" x 3 1/4" squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 52 quarter triangles.

- 5. From fabric E, cut for
- a. star blocks

9" blocks -

Widthwise, (1) 4 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (3) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" and (6) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares. Cut 4 1/4" squares diagonally twice to yield 24 quarter triangles.

6" blocks -

(1) 3 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (3) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" and (6) 3 1/4" x 3 1/4" squares. Cut 3 1/4" squares diagonally twice to yield 24 quarter triangles.

- 6. From fabric F, cut for
- a. star blocks

9" block -

Widthwise, (1) 4 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (1) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" and (2) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares. Cut 4 1/4" squares diagonally twice to yield 8 quarter triangles.

6" blocks -

Widthwise, (1) 2 1/2" x 42". Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.

Widthwise, (1) 3 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (8) 3 1/4" x 3 1/4" squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 32 quarter triangles.

b. inner border #2

Widthwise, cut (7) 1 ½" x 42" strips.

- 7. From fabric G, cut for
- a. star blocks

18" blocks -

Widthwise, (1) 6 1/2" x 42". Sub-cut (3) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.

Widthwise, (2) 7 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (6) 7 1/4" x 7 1/4") squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 24 quarter triangles.

12" blocks -

Widthwise, (1) 4 1/2" x 42". Sub-cut (3) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.

Widthwise, (1) 5 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (6) 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 24 quarter triangles.

9" blocks -

Widthwise, (1) 3 1/2" x 42". Sub-cut (4) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.

Widthwise, (1)  $4 \frac{1}{4}$  x 42". Sub-cut (8)  $4 \frac{1}{4}$  x  $4 \frac{1}{4}$  squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 32 quarter triangles.

6" blocks -

Widthwise, (1) 3 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (3) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares and (6) 3 1/4" x 3 1/4" squares. Cut 3 1/4" squares diagonally twice to yield 24 quarter triangles.

- 8. From fabric H, cut for
- a. star blocks

9" blocks -

Widthwise, (1) 4 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (2) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" and (4) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares. Cut 4 1/4" squares diagonally twice to yield 16 quarter triangles.

6" blocks -

Widthwise, (1) 2 1/2" x 42". Sub-cut (6) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.

Widthwise, (1) 3 1/4" x 42". Sub-cut (12) 3 1/4" x 3 1/4" squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield 48 quarter triangles.

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[Note: Instructions for Quilt Assembly are based on silver colorway, and are interchangeable for gold colorway.]

#### Constructing star blocks (using 18" Zinnia Silver block as example).

1. Arrange and sew together quarter triangles into a QST unit: 2 fabric G, 1 fabric C and 1 fabric A.



Repeat to make a total of 4 QST units.

2. Sew 2 QST units to the opposite sides of 1 (6 1/2" x 6 1/2") fabric G squares to make a row.



3. Sew 2 (6 1/2" x 6 1/2") fabric C squares to the opposite sides of 1 QST unit to make a row. Make a total of 2 rows.



4. Sew rows together to complete 1 block.



5. Repeat to make the remaining 18" star blocks in the colorways shown in quilt center diagram. Use the same process to make the remaining blocks in other size (6", 9", 12") using the pieces cut for the respective sizes, and in colorways shown in quilt center diagram.

### **Section Assembly**

#### 1. Section 1.


Section 1a. Sew 2 6" star blocks to the left of 1 12" star block, as shown.




Sew 3 6" star blocks into a row and add to the previously sewn section to complete section 1a.



Section 1b. Sew 4 9" star blocks in a 4-patch manner to complete section 1b, as shown.




Sew together 1 18" star block, section 1a and section 1b to complete Section 1.




#### 2. Section 2.

Section 2a. Sew 3 12" star blocks into a row. Sew 6 6" star blocks into a row and add to the bottom of the 12" star row to complete Section 2a.




Sew together Section 2a and 1 18" star block to complete Section 2.




#### 3. Section 3.


Section 3a. Sew 4 9" star blocks in a 4-patch manner to complete Section 3a.



Section 3b. Sew 2 18" star blocks to complete Section 3b, as shown.



Sew together Section 3a and Section 3b to complete Section 3.



#### 4. Section 4.


Section 4a. Sew 2 6" star blocks to the right of 1 12" star block, as shown.




Sew 3 6" star blocks into a row and add to the previously sewn section to complete section 4a.



Section 4b. Sew 4 9" star blocks in a 4-patch manner to complete section 4b, as shown.




Sew together 1 18" star block, section 4a and section 4b to complete Section 4.



## **Quilt Assembly**

1. Quilt center. Sew Sections 1-4 together to complete quilt center.



- 2. Inner border #1. Sew (2) 2" x 72 1/2" fabric A strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) 2" x 57 1/2" fabric A strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
- 3. Inner border #2. Sew (2)  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 75  $\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric F strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2)  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 59  $\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric F strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
- 4. Outer border. Sew (2)  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 77  $\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric B strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2)  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 67  $\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric B strips to the remaining short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



## **Quilting Instructions:**

- 1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich.
- 2. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Bind to finish quilt.
