24086 G - Scenic Print (directional)

- Cut (2) $16^{1 / 2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (3) $12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ blocks and (1) $51 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{1 / 2}$ " side border rectangle.
- Cut (1) $51 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) $51 ⁄ 22^{\prime \prime} \times 121 ⁄ 2 "$ bottom border rectangle.


## 24087 H - Patch Print (directional)

- Cut (2) $16 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (3) $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $161 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ blocks and (1) $51 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{1 / 2}$ " side border rectangle.
- Cut (1) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) $51 / 2{ }^{2} \times 12^{112} 2^{\prime \prime}$ top border rectangle.


## 24092 T - Rust Linen

- Cut (1) $8 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) $21 / 2$ " x $81 / 2 "$ rectangles.
- Cut (1) $51 / 2$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $51 / 2$ " x $5 ½$ " border corner squares.


## 24088 E - Branches

- Cut (9) $4122^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) $41 / 2$ " x $41 / 2 "$ squares

24090 T - Brown Tree Print (directional)

- Cut (1) $161 / 2$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $51 / 2$ " x $161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for the side borders. From the remainder of the strip, cut (1) $5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ remaining WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $51 / 2$ " $\times 12^{1 ⁄ 2}$ " top and bottom border rectangles.

24090 F - Dark Green Tree Print (directional)

- Cut (1) $161 / 2$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $51 / 2$ "x $161 / 2$ " rectangles for the side borders. From the remainder of the strip, cut (1) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ remaining WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $51 / 2$ " $\times 12^{1 / 2}$ " top and bottom border rectangles.
- Cut (5) $41 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) $41 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.


## 24090 G - Light Green Tree Print (directional)

- Cut (5) $4122^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) $41 / 2$ " x $81 / 2 "$ rectangles.


## 24091 A - Brown Houndstooth

- Cut (2) $81 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ x $81 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and (10) $21 / 2$ " x $81 / 2$ " rectangles.
- Cut (7) $2 ½ \mathrm{x}$ x WOF strips for binding.


## 24091 G - Green Houndstooth

- Cut (2) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (2) $51 / 2$ " x $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and (2) $51 / 2$ " $\times 161 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.


## 24089 B - Mountain Print (directional)

- Cut (2) 82 " x WOF strips for backing.


## Piecing Instructions:

Use $1 / 4$ " seam allowances

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ branches square.

2. Place a marked square, right sides together, on one corner of a $41 / 2$ " $\times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ " light green tree rectangle. Sew on the marked line. Trim the seam allowance to $1 / 4$ ". Press seam toward the square. Repeat for the other corner of the rectangle to complete one light green tree unit. Repeat to make 20 light green units.

3. Repeat Step 2 using the $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ branches squares and the $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ dark green tree print rectangles.

4. Join the light and dark green tree units. Press seam toward the light unit. Repeat for 20 units.


Make 20
5. Sew a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rust linen rectangle to the left side of a tree unit. Press the seam toward the rust rectangle. Repeat for 10 units.


Make 10
6. Sew a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ brown houndstooth rectangle to the right side of the rust-tree unit. Press seam toward the rectangle. Repeat for 10 units.

7. Sew a $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 88^{1 / 2}$ " brown houndstooth rectangle to the left side of a tree unit. Press seam toward the rectangle. Repeat for 10 units.

8. Join the units as shown to complete one block. Press seam toward the top unit. Repeat to make 10 blocks.

Quilt Assembly:

- Refer to the diagrams for fabric placement, paying careful attention to the directional fabrics.


1. Arrange and sew the border pieces, blocks, scenic print and patch print rectangles in rows as shown. Press seams in the direction of the arrows.
2. Join the rows to compete the quilt top. Press seams in one direction.
3. Remove selvage edges from backing pieces. Sew together on the long side with a $1 / 2$ " seam allowance. Press the seam open. Trim to make a $66^{\prime \prime} \times 82$ " backing piece.
4. Layer, quilt and bind using your favorite methods.
