Fabric A ........ MAS8760-W .......White Winter Roses................................1-1/2 yards
Fabric B......... MAS8764-G ........Green Romantic Scroll .........................1-1/8 yards*

* Includes Binding

Fabric C........ MAS8764-R .........Red Romantic Scroll .............................1-3/4 yards
Fabric D........ MAS8762-G ........Dark Green Roses \& Chickadees........3/8 yard
Fabric E......... MAS8761-W .......White Winter Berries .............................. $5 / 8$ yard
....................... Backing...............Your Choice........................................... 4 yards

## Culting

## Fabric A MAS8760-W

Cut (3) $6-1 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips
into (16) 6-1/8" squares.
Cut (6) 4-1/2" $\times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Piece the strips to make (2) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 52-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (2) 4-1/2" $\times 44-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips

## Fabric B MAS8764-G

Cut (1) 5" x 42" strip
into (8) 5" squares. Cut each square diagonally once to make (16) small triangles.
Cut (2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
Cut (3) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Piece the strips together to make two 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" strips.
Cut (6) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips for the binding

## Fabric C MAS8764-R

Cut (2) 5" $\times 42$ " strips
into (10) 5" squares. Cut each square diagonally once to make (20) small triangles.
Cut (1) 6-1/8" square
Cut (1) 9-1/4" $\times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strip
into (3) 9-1/4" squares. Cut each square across both diagonals to make (12) large triangles.
Cut (7) 4-1/2" x 42" strips. Piece the strips together to make (2) 4-1/2" x 60-1/2" strips and
(2) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 52-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

## Fabric D MAS8762-G

Cut (2) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips into (16) 4-1/2" squares

Fabric E MAS8761-W
Cut (3) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips. into (12) 4-1/2" squares and (4) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

## Backing

Cut (2) $68^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ pieces. Sew the rectangles together on the long edges and trim

This pattern was designed using an accurate $1 / 4$ " seam. Before beginning, please precisely cut (2) $1-1 / 2$ " $\times 5$ " pieces of fabric. Stitch them together along the 5 " edge. Press and measure across them at the midpoint on their width. They should be EXACTLY 2-1/2" across. If not, adjust your stitching and try again until correct.

## Construction

## Block Assembly Instructions:

1. Corner Blocks: Following the diagram, sew three Fabric C small triangles and one Fabric B small triangle to each side of one 6-1/8" Fabric A square. Finished block should measure 8-1/2" square. Make 4.

2. Side Blocks: Using the diagram as a guide, sew together two 6-1/8" Fabric A squares, two Fabric B small triangles, two Fabric C small triangles and two Fabric $C$ large triangles. Finished block measures 8-1/2" x 16-1/2". Make 4.

3. Center Block: Using the diagram below, sew together four 6-1/8" Fabric A squares, one 6-1/8" Fabric $C$ square, four Fabric $C$ large triangles and four Fabric B small triangles. Finished block measures 16-1/2" square. Make 1.


## Sashing Assembly Instructions:

4. Short Horizontal Sashing Strip: Sew one 4-1/2" Fabric E square to one 4-1/2" Fabric D square. Make 4.

5. Long Horizontal Sashing Strip: Sew one 4-1/2" Fabric $D$ square to each end of one $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip. Make 2.

6. Vertical Sashing Strip: Using the diagram as a guide for block placement, sew together four 4-1/2" Fabric D squares, four 4-1/2" Fabric E squares and one 4-1/2" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip. Make 2.

## Quilt Top Assembly Instructions:

Use the quilt top layout on next page as a guide while following the steps below to make the quilt top.
7. Sew together the four corner blocks (step 1), four side blocks (step 2), one center block (step 3), horizontal sashing pieces (steps $4 \& 5$ ) and vertical sashing strips (step 6) to make one $40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ quilt top.
8. Sew one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $B$ strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" Fabric $B$ strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
9. Sew one 4-1/2" $\times 44-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 52-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
10. Sew one $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 52-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $C$ strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $C$ strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
11. Press your quilt and layer it using your favorite method. Quilt as desired.
12. Sew the six $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strips together end-to-end with $45^{\circ}$ seams to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
13. Bind.
