## **Fabric Requirements**

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yard Kidz-CF4676 Pink

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yard Kidz-CF4679 Grey

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yard Dot-CF1820 Sweet

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yard Kidz-CF5577 Pink

<sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yard Kidz-CF4677 Cream

<sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yard Spin-CF5300 Cream

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yard Dot-CF1820 Shell

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yard Dot-CF1820 Pewter (binding)

21/2 yards Kidz-CF4678 Cream (backing)

## Other Supplies:

45" x 49" batting

Paper-back fusible web

## **Cutting**

From each of Kidz-CF4676 Pink (A), Kidz-CF4679 Grey (B), Dot-CF1820 Sweet (C) and Kidz-CF5577 Pink (D):

• See instructions to cut three hearts.

From both Kidz-CF4677 Cream (E) and Spin-CF5300 Cream (F):

• Cut two 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x width-of-fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut six 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares.

#### From Dot-CF1820 Shell (G):

• Cut three  $2^{1/2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut twelve  $2^{1/2}$ " x  $10^{1/2}$ " strips.

#### From Dot-CF1820 Pewter (H):

• Cut four 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips for binding.

### **Preparation**

- 1. Using the template, mirror-image the pattern to create a full-size heart. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace twelve heart templates onto the paper side of the fusible web. Rough-cut each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- 2. Noting the fabric print direction, press each fusible web heart onto the wrong side of the listed fabric. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

#### **Block Construction**

3. Referring to Figure 1, center and press one CF4676 Pink heart onto one 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" CF5300 Cream square. Repeat to make a total of three of Block One.



- 4. Repeat step 3 using CF4679 Grey and CF1820 Sweet hearts and 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" CF4677 Cream squares to make a total of three each of Block Two and Block Three.
- 5. Repeat step 3 using CF5577 Pink hearts and 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" CF5300 Cream squares to make a total of three of Block Four.
- Appliqué the raw edges of the heart shapes with a decorative stitch such as a zigzag, buttonhole or satin stitch to the squares.

## **Quilt Top Assembly**

All seam allowances are 1/4" and pieces are sewn right sides together.

- 7. Following the Quilt Assembly Diagram, lay out the blocks as shown, alternating with  $2^{1/2}$ " x  $10^{1/2}$ " CF1820 Shell strips.
- 8. Sew the blocks and strips together in each row. Matching adjacent seams, sew the four rows together in order to make the quilt top.

## **Finishing**

- 9. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing, and quilt as desired.
- 10. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
- 11. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
