# Fabric Requirements

Flying Geese:

1 Layer Cake<sup>™</sup> (7170LC) (42-10" x 10" squares)

Background & Border:

31/4 yards (9900 200)

**Binding:** 5% yard (7177 14)

Backing: 3½ yards

Fit to be Geese Ruler by Open Gate

(6½")(OGR 102)



### Cutting

### Flying Geese (1 Layer Cake<sup>™</sup>):

from EACH of the 42-Layer Cake<sup>™</sup> 10" x 10" squares cut:

1-7½" x 7½" square

cut the square twice diagonally to make 4 quarter square triangles You will have a total of 168 quarter square triangles.

## Background & Border:

18-41/4" x width of fabric strips

from the 18 strips cut 168-41/4" x 41/4" squares

cut the squares once diagonally to make a total of 336 half square triangles

7-4" x width of fabric strips (Border)

Sew 4 strips end to end. From this strip cut 2-4" x 60½" strips.

Sew 3 strips end to end. From this strip cut 2-4" x 55½" strips.


**Binding:** 7-2½" x width of fabric strips. Sew the 7 strips end to end.




#### Construction

(Use 1/4" seams and press in the direction of the arrows.)


1 Flying Geese: Sew 1-41/4" Background triangle to two sides of 1-71/2" print quarter square triangle. Make a total of 168 Flying Geese Blocks.







Flying Geese Make 168.


- Trimming the Flying Geese: Use the Fit to be Geese ruler to trim all four sides of the Flying Geese as follows:
  - (A) Lay the "roof" line of the ruler on top of the block along the block seams. Trim the top and right side of the block.






(B) Rotate the block 180°. Align the block with the rectangle on the ruler marked  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make sure the center line on the ruler is going through the point on the block. Trim the top and right side of the block.






(C) Repeat, trimming all of the flying geese.




Flying Geese 3½" x 6½" with seams Trim 168.

**3** Flying Geese Sets: Sew 4 *matching* Flying Geese blocks together as shown. Make 42 sets of matching Flying Geese. Press the Geese in one direction.



Flying Geese Sets 6½" x 12½" with seams Make 42.

Assembly: Sew 5 Flying Geese Sets together to make a column. Make 8 columns. (There will be 2 extra Flying Geese Sets.) Sew the columns together, turn every other row 180° as shown.



5 Borders: Add the 4" x 60½" Background strips to the sides of the quilt. Add the 4" x 55½" Background strips to the top and the bottom. Layer, quilt as desired and bind. ENJOY!
