Penny's Garden

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 50" x 57"

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

FABRIC & SUPPLIES NEEDED:

1. Plaid Pattern: 9 Fat Quarters
(2 Chevron, 2 White, 1 Aqua, 1 Lavendar, 1 Green, 1 Yellow, 1 Hot Pink)
2. Border: 5/8 yard
3. Name Applique and Binding Scallop: 1 yard
4. Stems: (use leftover green)
5. Flowers: 5 - 5" circles
6. Flower Centers: 5 - 1" Buttons
7. Heat N Bond Fusible Web - 1/2 yard (for name and stems)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

1. Plaid Pattern

Cut 1 - 18" x 20" (A)

Cut 1 - 18" x 20" (B)

Fabric 3: (Chevron)

Cut 2 - 9" x 20" (C)

Fabric 4: (Aqua)

Cut 2 - 6" x 20" (D)

Cut 1 - 6" x 6" (E)

Cut 1 - 6" x 4 1/2" (F)

Cut 1 - 6" x 1 1/2" (G)

Fabric 5: (Yellow)

Cut 2 - 6" x 20" (H)

Cut 1 - 6" x 8 1/2" (I)

Fabric 6: (Lavendar)

Cut 2 - 3 1/2" x 20" (J)

Cut 1 - 3 1/2" x 18" (K)

Cut 1 - 3 1/2" x 12" (L)

Cut 1 - 3 1/2" x 9" (M)

Cut 2 - 3 1/2" x 1 1/2" (N)

Fabric 7: (Pink)

Cut 2 - 3 1/2" x 20" (O)

Cut 1 - 3 1/2" x 18" (P)

Cut 1 - 3 1/2" x 9" (Q)

Cut 1 - 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" (R)

Cut 2 - 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" (S)

Cut 1 - 3 1/2" x 1 1/2" (T)

Fabric 8: (Green)

Cut 1 - 6" x 18" (U)

Cut 1 - 6" x 11" (V)

Cut 1 - 6" x 9" (W)

Cut 1 - 6" x 4 1/2" (X)

Fabric 9: (White)


Cut 6 - 1 1/2" x 20" (Y)

Cut 2 - 1 1/2" x 18" (Z)


Cut 2 - 1 1/2" x 9" (AA)

Cut 6 - 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" (AB)


Cutting Diagram Layout









2. Border:

Cut 6 - 2 1/2" strips x WOF (width of fabric).

3. Binding Scallop

Cut 7 - 3" strips x WOF.

Cut into segments: 84 - 3".


Make template of 3" binding scallop circle.

Use template to make 84" - 3" circles.

Sewing Instructions:


1. Section 1:

Stitch together the following pieces lengthwise:
2. Section 2:
Repeat instructions for Section 1 substituting B for A.




2. Section 3:

Stitch together the following pieces lengthwise:
Press seams down toward U.




3. Section 4:

Stitch together the following pieces:
Press seams down toward W.



4. Section 5: (Follow arrows for pressing seams)

- a. Stitch together X, E & V.
- b. Stitch together AB, G, AB, N & AB.
Stitch L to top of unit.
Stitch S to left side of unit.
- c. Stitch together AB, N & AB.
Stitch R to top of unit.
Stitch F to left side of unit.
- d. Stitch together T & AB.
Stitch S to top of unit.
Stitch unit to left side of F (in c unit).
- e. Stitch c/d unit to top of b unit.
Stitch I to right side of unit.
Stitch (a) unit to bottom of unit.



5. Name Applique


Mark desired letters (reversed) on paper side of fusible web.
Press fusible web to wrong side of applique fabric.
Cut letters out on marked lines.
Remove paper.
Place as desired on quilt.
Press.
Stitch on with tight zig-zag or decorative stitch.

6. Stem and Leaf Applique


Make template of leaf and leaf reversed.
Mark 4 leaves and 3 reverse leaves on paper side of fusible web.
Cut 4" x 10" piece of fusible web for stems.
Press leaves and stem fusible web to wrong side of leftover green fabric.
Cut leaves out on marked lines.
Cut 5 stems of varying heights that are 1/2" wide.
Remove paper.
Arrange stems and leaves as desired on quilt.
Press.
Stitch on with tight zig-zag or decorative stitch.

7. Quilt Construction


Stitch Section 3 to right side of Section 5.
Stitch Section 4 to left side of Section 5.
Stitch Section 1 to top.
Stitch Section 2 to bottom.

8. Border

Stitch 6 - 2 1/2" strips together end to end.
Cut into segments: 2 - 53 1/2", 2 - 50 1/2".
Stitch 53 1/2" segments to right and left sides.
Stitch 50 1/2" segments to top and bottom.

9. Quilt as desired, leaving at least 1/2" unquilted around perimeter.

10. Scallop Binding

With right sides together, place 2 - 3" scallop binding circles together.
Stitch 1/4" around circle.
Fold in half and finger press.
Unfold and cut on fold line.
Turn right side out and press.
Repeat to make 84 - scallops.
Pin 22 scallops to sides and 20 scallops to top and bottom.
Stitch to top and batting only. *You will have to fold the quilt back away as you are stitching.
Turn quilt back over and tuck under to match the front.
Whip stitch back to scallop binding pieces.
