





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Cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (3934-92 Love Letters - Black/Pink), cut:

• See instructions to cut (3) large hearts.

Fabric B (3935-80 OXO - White/Red), cut:

• See instructions to cut (3) large hearts.

Fabric C (3933-92 Big Hearts - Black/Pink), cut:

• See instructions to cut (5) large hearts.

Fabric D (3936-20 Small Hearts - White/Pink), cut:

• See instructions to cut (2) large hearts.

Fabric E (3933-20 Big Hearts - White/Pink), cut:

- See instructions to cut (5) large hearts.
- See instructions to cut (16) small hearts.

Fabric F (3937-92 Words - Black/Pink), cut:

• See instructions to cut (2) large hearts.

Fabric G (Surf-75 Peppered Cottons – Surf), cut:

- (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric H (Deep Space-98 Peppered Cottons - Deep Space), cut:

- (7) 12 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (20) 12 ½" squares.
- (1) 10" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 10" squares.

Fabric I (3931-92 Border Stripe - Black/Pink), cut:

- (2) 10" x 62 ½" LOF strips.
- (2) 10" x 50 ½" LOF strips.

Fabric J (3936-92 Small Hearts – Black/Pink), cut:

- (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 81 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 71 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Backing (3935-80 OXO - White/Red), cut:

• (2) 91" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 79" x 91" for the back.



Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

Block Assembly

- 1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- 2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- 3. Refer to the Figure 1 to arrange and press (1) Fabric A large heart onto (1) $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H square.
- 4. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block One square.
- 5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make (3) Block One squares total.



6. Repeat Steps 3-4 and use Figures 2 through 6 for fabric identification to make (3) Block Two squares, (5) Block Three squares, (2) Block Four squares, (5) Block Five squares and (2) Block Six squares.




7. Repeat Steps 3-4 using (4) Fabric E small hearts and (1) 10" Fabric H square to make (1) Block Seven square as shown in Figure 7. Repeat to make (4) Block Seven squares total.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

- 8. Sew (4) assorted heart blocks together to make (1) row. Repeat to make (5) rows total.
- 9. Sew the (5) rows together to make the Center Block.

- 10. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 11. Sew (1) $10^n \times 62 \frac{1}{2}^n$ Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Block Seven square to each end of (1) $10^n \times 50 \frac{1}{2}^n$ Fabric I strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.


12. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 81 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 71 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to both the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

Layering, Quilting and Finishing


13. Press the quilt top and 79" x 91" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.


Binding

- 14. Cut the ends of the (8) Fabric J binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.
- 15. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
