Fabric Requirements and Cutting Instructions

Requirements are based on 42" fabric width.

Fabrics are cut on the width of fabric (WOF). When cut on the length of fabric, the notation LOF will be indicated.

33631-14 Cherry on Top – Buttercup (A)	1/3 yard	*(2) 3-5/8" x WOF strips.
33633-23 Blooming Blossoms – Petal (B)	1/3 yard	*(2) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) 3-1/2" squares.
33635-15 Leafy Polka – Aloe (C)	3/8 yard	*(5) 2" x WOF strips.
33636-17 Picnic Spot – Bluebell (D)	1/2 yard	*(2) 8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (7) 8" squares.
33630-21 Garden Growing - Eggshell Pastel (E)	5/8 yard	*(18) Fans using the template and fusible web.
33632-13 Ma's Sewing Box – Petal (F)	5/8 yard	*(18) Fans using the template and fusible web.
33633-26 Blooming Blossoms – Sky (G)	5/8 yard	*(18) Fans using the template and fusible web.
33635-18 Leafy Polka – Scarlet (H)	5/8 yard	*(18) Fans using the template and fusible web.

33637-18 Dotty – Scarlet (L)	7/8 yard	*(10) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.
33631-11 Cherry on Top – Eggshell (M)	1-1/8 yards	*(4) 8-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 8-1/2" squares.
33632-17 Ma's Sewing Box – Bluebell (N)	1-1/4 yards	*(10) 4" x WOF strips for border 4.
33637-15 Dotty – Aloe (O)	1-1/3 yards	*(5) 8-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 8-1/2" squares.

9900-11 Bella Solids – Snow (P)	2-1/8 yards	*(5) 2"x WOF strips. *(3) 3-1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) squares; cut once diagonally. (X) *(2) 5-3/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) 5-3/4" squares; cut twice diagonally. (Y) *(2) 8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (7) 8" squares. *(9) 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 3. *(7) 2" x WOF strips for border 1.

Assemble Blocks

Notes:

a. Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. If no direction is specified, press seams toward the darker fabric.




Table 1. Colorway for each block.




Figure 1 – Make 108 units.

1. Trace the fan shape on the plastic to make templates. Cut on the outline. Trace the shape on the smooth side of the fusible web 108 times. Cut them 1/8" outside the outline, then remove the center of the fusible web inside the fans, leaving about 3/8" near the edges, making them hollow (figure 1). Fuse the eighteen shapes to the wrong side of each of the fabrics E, F, G, H, I, J, cut on the outline, and remove the paper backing.

2. Fold and crease the 8-1/2" Fabrics M and O squares in half diagonally once. Referring to Table 1 for fabric combination and placement, position the middle fan on the squares using the creased fold as a guideline. Then, add a fan to each side of the center one, making sure there is 1/4" space between the edge of the outer fans and the edge of the background squares for the seam allowance (figure 2). Fuse them according to the manufacturer's instructions.




3. Sew together the 8-1/2" units four-by-four according to the diagrams below to make nine 16-1/2" blocks. Press the seams open. Place the circle shape onto a lightbox or windowpane. Layer the fusible web onto it and trace it nine times. Cut each shape 1/8" outside the outline, remove the center of each circle as in Step 1, and fuse to the wrong side of fabric K. Cut on the outline and remove the paper backing. Fuse one circle to the middle of each block (*figure 3*). Machine appliqué the fans and the circles using monofilament and the zigzag stitch.




Figure 4 – Make (56) 3-1/2" units.

4. Mark two diagonal lines on the wrong side of the 8" Fabric P squares (a). Layer a marked Fabric P square atop a 8" Fabric D square. Stitch ¼" on each side of the marked lines (b), cut vertically and horizontally to make four equal squares (c), then cut each square on the drawn lines to make eight half-square triangles (d). Press open and trim to 3-1/2". (figure 4). Repeat with the remaining Fabrics P and D squares to make a total of fifty-six half-square triangles (HST).

5. Sew a 2" Fabric P strip to a 2" Fabric C strip to make a strip set. Press open. Repeat to make five strip sets. Cross-cut the strip sets into fifty-six 3-1/2" sections (*figure 5*). Press the seam toward the dark fabric.

6. Noting fabric orientation, sew one Step 5 section to opposite sides of a 3-1/2" Fabric B square (*figure 6*). Press the seams away from the center. Repeat to make fourteen center rows.




Figure 7 – Make (14) 9-1/2" blocks.

7. Noting fabric orientation, sew one Step 5 unit between two Step 4 HST. Press the seams toward the center. Repeat to make twenty-eight rows. Sew one row to the top and one to the bottom of the Step 6 center rows to make fourteen 9-1/2" blocks (*figure 7*). Press the seams in one direction.




Figure 8 – Make (14) units.

8. Sew a 3-5/8" Fabric K strip to each side of a 3-5/8" Fabric A strip to make a strip set. Press the seams toward the center. Repeat to make two strip sets. Cross-cut the strip sets into fourteen 3-5/8" sections. Sew a Fabric P triangle X to each short end of the sections (figure 8). Press the seams away from the center.




Figure 9 – Make (14) 9-1/2" blocks.

9. Sew a Fabric P triangle Y to opposite sides of a 3-5/8" Fabric K square. Press the seams away from the center. Sew a Fabric P triangle X to the top of this row. Repeat to make twenty-eight units. Sew one unit to the top and one to the bottom of the Step 8 sections to make fourteen 9-1/2" blocks (*figure 9*).


Assemble Quilt Top

- 10. Referring to the quilt photo for block placement and color orientation, lay out three rows of three Step 3 blocks and join the blocks together in each row. Press the seams in one direction.
- 11. For border 1, join the seven 2" Fabric P border strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders. The quilt measures 54-1/2" x 54-1/2" up to here.
- 12. For border 2 and referring to the quilt photo for block placement, arrange three each Steps 8 and 9 blocks for each side of the quilt. Sew blocks together and repeat to make another strip. Sew one border strip to each side of the quilt center. Press the seams toward the quilt center.
- 13. Repeat Step 12 with four each Steps 8 and 9 blocks and sew one border strip to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt center.
- 14. Repeat Step 11 with the nine 1-1/2" Fabric P strips to make and add border 3.
- 15. Repeat Step 11 with the ten 4" Fabric N strips to make and add border 4.

Finishing


16. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the quilt top.

17. Join the ten 2-1/2" Fabric L binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
