Kit Includes:

- 2 yds Soft Cuddle Fancy Leopard
- (9-8" strips cut on the lines)
- 5/8 yd Cuddle 3 Camel
- 1/2 yd Soft Cuddle Black borders (cut 5-3"strips)

Need to buy:

- 2 1/2 yds Soft Cuddle Black backing and binding (cut 5-2 1/2"strips)
- 2 yds Batting. (Optional)
- One can of Spray Adhesive



Instructions:

- Cut 9-8" strips from the Fancy Leopard on the line so that you have two sections on each strip. It is best to cut this with the scissors one layer at a time.
- Cut 5-3" strips from the Soft Cuddle Black for the accent borders.
- Cut 2-6" strips and 2-4" strips from the Cuddle 3 Camel for accent strips.
- Cut 7 of the Fancy Leopard strips down to 40" long for the center of the quilt.
- Prepare your backing fabric by marking a vertical and horizontal center line. Use a light chalk or pins. Measure out 20" on each side of the vertical line and mark a line from the top of the quilt to the bottom as a start and stop line for the center section as shown on the diagram above.
- Place a Fancy Leopard strip on the center horizontal line. Be sure that you have it centered both ways. Using Spray Adhesive, fuse the strip in place.

In the following steps you will be using the "Sew and Flip" method:

- Sew the 6" strips of Camel on the top and bottom of the center strip. Spray- fuse them in place.
- Add the next set of Fancy Leopard strips. Spray- fuse them in place.
- Add the 4" strips and then the next set of Fancy Leopard strips, fusing down each set after sewing.
- Add the Soft Cuddle Black border strip to the outside edge on the outside vertical line. You may need to re-draw that line so your border is straight. Spray-fuse the border in place.
- Sew the Fancy Leopard outside border strip to each side of the quit. Spray fuse.
- Sew the Soft Cuddle Black strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Spray fuse.
- To make the corner strip take two of the scraps from the Fancy Leopard strips and cut them 8"x the width of the strip; place right sides together. Draw a line diagonally from each corner. Sew on that line. Carefully cut 3/8" from the line. Before you cut, open the square up both directions to make sure your lines are going the direction you want.
- Sew a piece of the Soft Cuddle Black border strips to the ends of each of the Fancy Leopard border strips; then sew on the corner set. Sew that entire strip onto the top and bottom of the quilt. Spray fuse. Yeah!! You're almost finished.
- Cut 5-2 1/2" strips of Soft Cuddle Black for binding. Sew the binding on the top of the quilt and fold to the back with the nap folding around to the back. I like to use a good 1/2" seam allowance but, because the Soft Cuddle has a longer nap, be sure to watch the outside edge when topstitching or you won't catch the edges. I like to fold the raw edge under about 1/2".
- Enjoy your soft and cuddly quilt. This quilt is very washable, just use cold water and dry on very low heat-just enough to fluff. Hang to finish drying. These textures are heat set and the heat of the dryer can change the designs of the Cuddle fabrics.
