

Quilt Design by Mary Kay Davis for Threads on the Floor.





Finished Quilt Size: 52" x 69"

Block Sizes: 12"

Be sure to read through instructions before beginning. Cutting instructions include 1/4" seam allowance. Yardage is based on 42" of usable fabric width. All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) unless otherwise stated. Press all seams as you assemble your blocks. Border lengths given are exact measure ments. You may want to cut borders slightly longer to allow for variations in seams and mitering corners.

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Hitching a Ride Grey 126.101.01.2	1/2 yard
Pecking Hens Ivory 126.101.02.2	1/3 yard
Daisy Turquoise 126.101.03.2	1/2 yard
Confetti Flower Coral 126.101.04.1	1/4 yard
Confetti Flower Ivory 126.101.04.2	1/3 yard
Owl's Perch Gold 126.101.05.1	1/4 yard
Owl's Perch Turquoise 126.101.05.2	1/2 yard
Egg Hunt Pink 126.101.06.2	1/2 yard
Setting Triangles, Corner Triangles and	
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Background Triangles:

Egg Hunt Navy 126.101.06.1 2-1/8 yards

Binding:

Egg Hunt Pink 126.101.06.2 1/2 yard

Backing:

Any Garden Roost Pattern 3-1/4 yards

Fan Blocks:

Using Template A to create blocks:

From Owl's Perch Gold & Confetti Flower Coral - Cut 4 each. From Pecking Hens Ivory & Confetti Flower Ivory - Cut 8 each. From Hitching a Ride Grey, Daisy Turquoise, Owl's Perch Turquoise & Egg Hunt Pink - Cut 12 each.

Background Triangles for Fan Blocks:

From Egg Hunt Navy - Cut (18) 7-1/4" squares. Subcut diagonally in both directions to create (4) quarter-square triangles for a total of 72 background triangles.

Setting Triangles:

From Egg Hunt Navy - Cut (3) 18-1/2" squares. Subcut diagonally in both directions to create (4) quarter-square triangles per square. Only (10) are required for the quilt (there will be 2 leftover). These are cut oversized so that the quilt may be squared up after they are attached.

Corner Triangles:

From Egg Hunt Navy - Cut (2) 9-1/2" squares. Subcut diagonally in one direction to create (4) corner triangles. These are also cut oversized so that the quilt may be squared up after they are attached.

Per Quilt Diagram - Lay out blocks in diagonal rows attaching a setting triangle to each row. Sew the rows together.

Attach a corner triangle to each corner.

Binding:

From Egg Hunt Pink - Cut (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

Sew the (7) 2-1/2" strips together to create a single strip. Fold in half lengthwise, press and attach to sides of quilt after quilting.



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
