Finished Quilt Size: 70 1/2" x 82 1/2" Finished Block Size: 4" x 4"

Cutting Directions:

From Fabric A, for quilt center,

(1) 4 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (7) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.

(9) 4 7/8" x WOF. Sub-cut (65) 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" squares.

For inner border top strip, (2) 4 1/2" x WOF. Piece strips and sub-cut (1) 4 1/2" x 64 1/2" strip.

For outer border cut, (4) 3" x WOF. Piece strips and sub-cut (1) 3" x 71" and (1) 3" x 76 1/2" strip. (4) 4 1/2" x WOF. Piece strips and sub-cut (1) 4 1/2" x 71" and (1) 4 1/2" x 76 1/2" strip.

From Fabric B, for quilt center,

(4) 4 7/8" x WOF. Sub-cut (29) 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" and (1) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.

From Fabric C, for quilt center,

(7) 4 7/8" x WOF. Sub-cut (49) 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" and (5) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.

From Fabric D, cut for quilt center,

(4) 4 7/8" x WOF. Sub-cut (26) 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" and (2) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.

From Fabric E, cut for quilt center,

(1) 4 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (5) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.

(4) 4 7/8" WOF. Sub-cut (43) 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" squares.

From Fabric F, cut for quilt center,

(4) 4 7/8" x WOF. Sub-cut (27) 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" and (1) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.

From Fabric G, cut for quilt center,

(4) 4 7/8" x WOF. Sub-cut (23) 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" and (1) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.


From Fabric H, cut for quilt center,

(1) 4 7/8" x WOF. Sub-cut (4) 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" squares.


For binding, cut at 2 1/4" x WOF strips and pieced together to make a long continuous strip.

Construction

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" Fabric A square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" Fabric E square. Sew 1/4" away from, and on left and right sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield 2 HST units.




2. Make the indicated total number of HST units in the following colorways:




Quilt Center

[Note: For ease of construction, quilt center is constructed in sections. Sections are sewn together to complete quilt center.]

1. Refer to diagram of quilt sections, arrange and sew together appropriate HST units and 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares [if applicable] to make pieced rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt sections.






Section 3 - sew sub-sections together to complete


Sub-section 1

2. Sew Sections 1 and 2 to make top half of quilt center. Sew Sections 3 and 4 to make bottom half of quilt center. Sew top and bottom halves to complete quilt center.



Quilt Assembly:

- 1. Inner border top strip. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric A strip to the top of quilt center.
- 2. Outer border. Sew border strips in the following order to complete quilt top.

Left: (1) 4 1/2" x 76 1/2" Fabric A strip Right: (1) 3" x 76 1/2" Fabric A strip Top: (1) 3" x 71" Fabric A strip

Bottom: (1) 4 1/2" x 71" Fabric A strip

Finishing

- 1. Layer quilt top, batting and backing together.
- 2. Baste and quilt as desired.
- 3. Attach binding to complete quilt.
