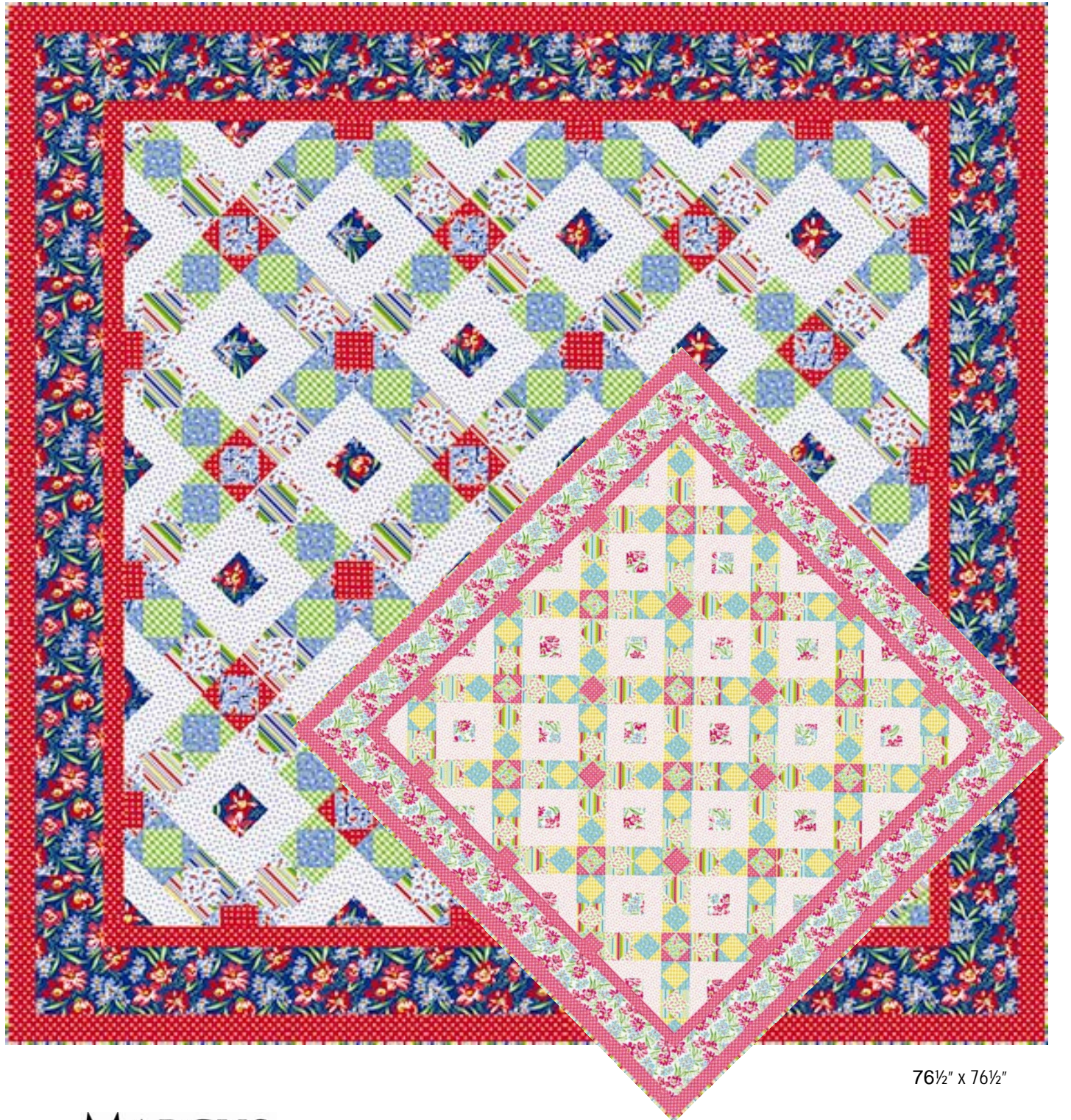

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS & CUTTING GUIDE

Finished Size Approx 76½" x 76½"

	Red	Pink	Yardages
Fabric A-White Ditsy Flower	0130-0174	0130-0138	1-3/4 yards
Cut five 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into sixty-four 3" x 3 ½" strips.			
Cut five 8 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into sixty-four 3" x 8 ½" strips.			
Fabric B-Stripe	5599-0174	5599-0138	1-5/8 yards*
Cut three 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into twenty-two 4 ½" squares.			
Cut seven 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (112) 2 ½" squares.			
Cut eight 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.			
Fabric C-Box Flower	5560-0174	5560-0138	1 yard
Cut four 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into twenty-eight 4 ½" squares.			
Cut six 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into eighty-eight 2 ½" squares.			
Fabric D-Plaid	5563-0174	5563-0138	1 yard
Cut three 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into twenty-six 4 ½" squares.			
Cut six 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into ninety-six 2 ½" squares.			
Fabric E-Dot Flower	5569-0174	5569-0138	1-1/2 yards
Cut eight 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew together and cut two 2 ½" x 76 7/8" strips and two 2 ½" x 72 7/8" squares.			
Cut seven 2" x WOF strips. Sew together and cut two 2" x 62 7/8" strips and two 2" x 59 7/8" strips.			
Cut two 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into eighteen 4 ½" squares.			
Cut three 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into forty-eight 2 ½" squares.			
Fabric F-Tossed Daisies	5598-0174	5598-0138	2/3 yard
Cut two 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into twelve 4 1/2" squares.			
Cut five 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into seventy-two 2 ½" squares.			
Fabric G-Large Floral	5597-0174	5597-0138	1-2/3 yards
Cut three 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into thirty-two 3 ½" squares.			
Cut eight 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew together and cut two 5 ½" x 62 7/8" strips and two 5 ½" x 72 7/8" strips.			
Fabric H-Triangle Flowers	5571-0174	5571-0138	1 yard
Cut three 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into twenty-four 4 ½" squares.			
Cut six 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (104) 2 ½" squares.			
Back-Box Flower	5560-0174	5560-0138	5 yards
Cut two 84" x WOF strips. Sew together and trim to make one 84" x 84" back.

Block Assembly

1. Place one 2 1/2" Fabric B square on the top left corner of one 4 1/2" Fabric C square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew along the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.
2. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 2 1/2" Fabric B square to each of the remaining corners of the 4 1/2" Fabric C square to make a 4 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 4).
3. Repeat Step 1-2 to make twenty-eight Block One squares.
4. Repeat Steps 1-2 with twenty-four 4 1/2" Fabric H squares and ninety-six 2 1/2" Fabric D squares to make twenty-four Block Two squares (Fig. 5).
5. Repeat Steps 1-2 with twenty-two 4 1/2" Fabric B squares and eighty-eight 2 1/2" Fabric C squares to make twenty-two Block Three squares (Fig. 6).
6. Repeat Steps 1-2 with twelve 4 1/2" Fabric F squares and forty-eight 2 1/2" Fabric E squares to make twelve Block Four squares (Fig. 7).
7. Repeat Steps 1-2 with eighteen 4 1/2" Fabric E squares and seventy-two 2 1/2" Fabric F squares to make eighteen Block Five squares (Fig. 8).
8. Repeat Steps 1-2 with twenty-six 4 1/2" Fabric D squares and (104) 2 1/2" Fabric H squares to make twenty-four Block Six squares (Fig. 9).
9. Sew one 3" x 3 1/2" Fabric A strip to each side of one 3 1/2" Fabric G square. Sew one 3" x 8 1/2" Fabric A strip to the top and bottom of the 3 1/2" Fabric G square to make one 8 1/2" Block Seven square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make thirty-two Block Seven squares total.

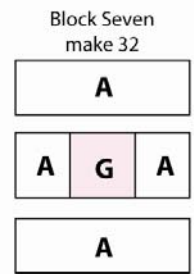
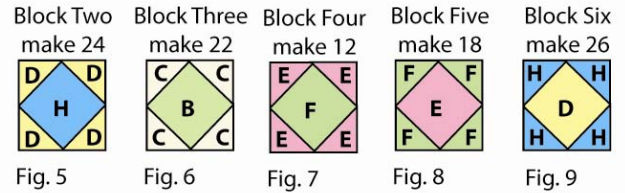
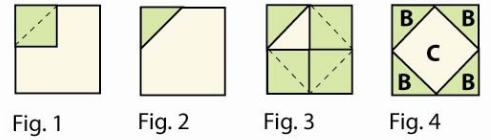
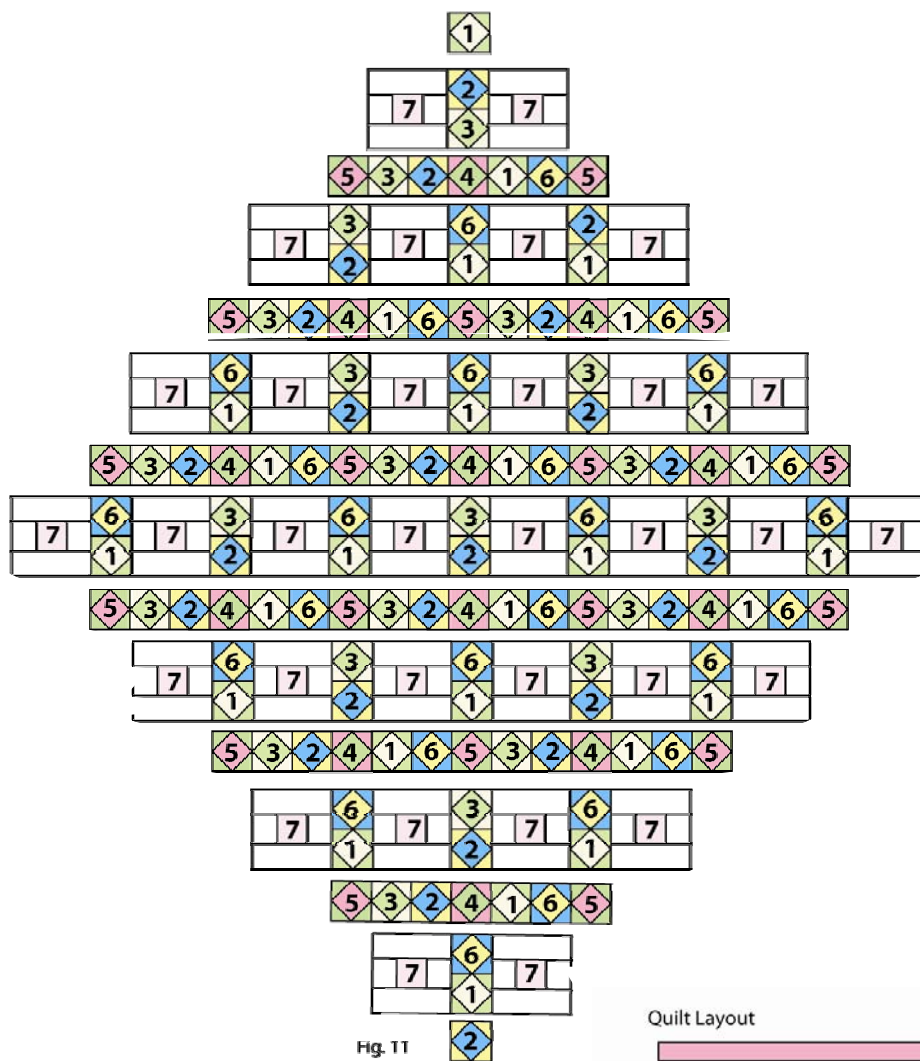

Quilt Assembly (refer to the quilt layout while assembling the quilt top)

10. Following Figure 11 (Page 4), sew the assorted 4 1/2" square blocks and the thirty-two 8 1/2" Block Seven square together into rows. Sew the rows together to make the quilt top.
11. Trim the quilt top to measure 59-7/8" square.
12. Sew one 2" x 59-7/8" Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2" x 62 7/8" Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
13. Sew one 5 1/2" 62-7/8" Fabric G strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 5 1/2" 72-7/8" Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
14. Sew one 2 1/2" x 72-7/8" Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2 1/2" x 76 7/8" Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
15. Layer and quilt as desired.
16. Sew the eight 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45° seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
17. Bind as desired.
