FLAPPERS and Friends

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 40½" x 47"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

2 Happy Flappers 5-inch Stackers (5-4020-21)

½ yard (50 cm) blue petal (C4026 Blue)

¾ yard (70 cm) cream shade (C200-02 Cream)

Binding ⅝ yard (60 cm)

Backing 2¾ yards (2.55 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border and sashing pieces.

5-inch Stackers

Cut the following assorted print 5" squares in half to create 4 rectangles 2½" x 5" from each print.

blue twirls, green twirls, red twirls

blue petal, green petal, pink petal

Blue Petal

Cut 4 strips 3½" x WOF for Border 2.

Cream Shade

Cut 5 strips 2½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 5 rectangles 2½" x 31" for sashing.

Cut 4 strips 2½" x WOF for Border 1.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

Happy Flapper Rows

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics as each row is a different combination of fabrics. Sew 5 assorted print 5" squares and 4 assorted print 2½" x 5" rectangles together to create a row. Repeat to create 6 Happy Flapper Rows.

Quilt Center Assembly

See quilt photo for row and sashing placement. Lay out the 6 Happy Flappers Rows and the 5 cream shade 2½" x 31" sashing rectangles. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 37½". Top and bottom borders should be 35".

Border 2

Side borders should be 41½". Top and bottom borders should be 41".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Happy Flappers Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
