

Block One: Use a precise 1/4" seam allowance.


 Sew a 1-1/2" x WOF Fabric 4 strip to each side of a 2-3/4" x WOF Fabric 2 strip to make a strip. Make 4.




2. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 4-3/4" x 7-1/8" units.




3. Sew a Fabric 7 triangle to each side of a pink/floral unit (step 2) to make a side unit. Make (12) side units total.




4. Sew a pink/floral unit to each side of a 4-3/4" Fabric 1 square to make a middle unit. Make (6) middle units total.



5. Sew a side unit to each of the long sides of a middle unit, centered on the Fabric 1 square.



6. Trim the block to measure 12-1/2" square. Make (6) total of Block One. Make sure all blocks are trimmed to the same size.



Block Two:

7. Repeat Steps 1-6 using (8) 1-1/2" x WOF Fabric 5 strips and (4) 2-3/4" x WOF Fabric 3 strips for steps 1 & 2; twenty-four Fabric 6 triangles for step 3 and (6) 4-3/4" Fabric 1 squares for step 4 to make (6) total of Block Two.



Press all seam allowances in the green blocks opposite the direction used in the pink blocks.


Quilt Assembly

Refer to the quilt layout diagram (on page 3) while assembling the quilt top:


8. Sew a Block One to either side of a Block Two to make Row 1. Repeat to make Row 3.



9. Sew a Block Two to either side of a Block One to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.



10. Sew the rows together in numerical order to make the guilt top (1-2-3-4).








Borders:


- 11. Sew (3) strips of Fabric 8 end-to-end with 45° seams, from that cut (2) 2" x 48-1/2" inner border strips.
- 12. Sew a 2" x 48-1/2" Fabric 8 strip to each long side of quilt top. Sew a 2" x 39-1/2" Fabric 8 strip to the top and a to the bottom of the quilt.

13. Center a 6-1/2" x 66" Fabric 9 border strip on one side of the quilt top and pin in place. Start sewing the strip 1/4" from the top edge of the quilt top and stop 1/4" from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.



14. Sew a 6-1/2" x 54" Fabric 9 border strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from

each end of the quilt top. To miter each corner, fold quilt top on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides.




Finishing

16. Layer and quilt as desired.

step with the remaining corners.

- 17. Sew the (6) 2-1/2" x WOF binding strips together, end-to-end with 45° seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 18. Bind as desired.

	Fabric 4 MAS8456-P2 1/2 yd	From Fabric 4, cut: 8 — strips 1½" x WOF
	Fabric 5 MAS8456-G 1/2 yd	From Fabric 5, cut: 8 — strips 1½" x WOF
	Fabric 6 MAS8456-GT 1/2 yd	From Fabric 6, cut: 6 — 8" squares Cut squares diagonally twice to make (24) quarter square tri- angles.
	Fabric 7 MAS8456-E 1/2 yd	From Fabric 7, cut: 6 — 8" squares Cut squares diagonally twice to make (24) quarter square tri- angles.





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
