

#### **Sewing Instructions:**

All seam allowances are 1/4". Pieces are sewn right sides together. Press all seams open. This pattern assumes a basic knowledge of Fondation paper piecing.

**1. Pine Tree Units:** Complete the (16) Foundation 1 units as shown, piecing fabric in the number order given. Trim foundations units on the outside solid line. Leave the paper intact.

### 2. Tree Top Units:

Similar to Foundation 1 piecing, make Foundation 2 units. *NOTE:* Foundation 2 sections 2-5 are pieced using **A** half-square triangles.





**3.** Add **A** Template 4 to top of Foundation 2 units to complete tree top. Make (16) tree top units.



**4. Tree Bottom Units:** Sew **A** Templates 1 and 2 pieces to sides of **D**, **C** and **E** Template 3 pieces as shown.









**5. Pine Tree Wedges:** Sew Tree Top units and Tree Bottom units to Pine Tree units as shown. Make (4) of each unit.



**Tree Skirt Assembly** Refer to skirt diagram on page 3.


- **6. Quarter Units:** Sew (4) pine tree wedges into four quarters as shown.
- 7. Half Units: Sew (2) quarter units into two halves.
- 8. Sew the halves together, leaving one side open. Remove all the papers.

#### **FINISHING**

Layer the backing right side down, batting, and tree skirt top right side up, easing so that the open raw edges of the tree skirt top meet, but do not overlap. Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing around the outside circle, between the raw edges, and the inside circle.

Bind with **B** 2-1/4" strips, using diagonal seams to make a bias binding. Sew the binding around the entire outer circle, inner circle and (2) open edges of the tree skirt. Turn the binding to the back and secure in place by hand or machine.










6. MAKE (4) QUARTER UNITS
