Snappy Strap

Supplies Needed:

Main Fabric: 6 ½" x WOF (width of fabric) Accent Fabric: 2 ½" x WOF Fusible Interfacing: 2 ½" strip 2 key rings or clasps

Cutting Instructions:

1. Main Fabric

Cut 1 – 6 1/2" x WOF. Cut off selvage edges. 2. Accent Fabric Cut 2 – 2 1/2" x 3" pieces. 3. Fusible Interfacing Cut 2 – 2 1/2" x 3" pieces.

Sewing Instructions

1. Strap

With RST (right sides together), fold main fabric strip in half lengthwise and stitch 1/4" down long side.

2. Accent Tubes

Press wrong side of 21/2" x 3" accent piece to bumpy side of 21/2" x 3" interfacing piece.
Fold top (3" side) down about 1/2" and press.
Repeat for bottom.
Top stitch along top and bottom.
Fold in half so that raw edges are together.
Stitch 1/4" down side.
Turn right sides out.
Repeat to make 2.
String accent tube onto strap.



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3. Construction

Fold ends of camera strap together to be about 1" across.



Fold back 1/2" and add key ring. Fold back another 1/2" over ring and stitch down. Bring accent tube over seam. Repeat for other side. Attach rings to camera.
