## Supply List

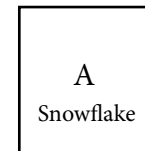
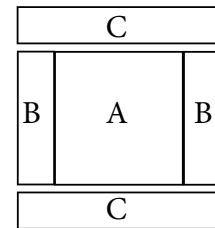
- One full panel of 30 Snowflakes - for snowflake blocks and border snowflake triangles
- 3/8 yard Rickrack - for snowflake block sashing
- 1/3 yard Snowstorm - for snowflake block sashing
- 1 3/4 yards Ornament Dot - for snowflake block sashing and inner border (**CUT INNER BORDERS FIRST**)
- 2 1/4 yards Cross Stitch - for alternate blocks, setting triangles and corner triangles
- 4 1/2 yards Snowmen - quilt back
- 5/8 yard Rickrack - quilt binding
- 77"x 77" batting

## Snowflake Blocks - Make 16

- ❄ 4 Blocks are sashed with Ornament Dot (**Cut the Inner Borders First!**)
- ❄ 7 Blocks are sashed with Rick Rack
- ❄ 5 Blocks are sashed with Snowstorm

For each 9" Snowflake Block, Cut:

- ❄ One A - 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" snowflake square (Center snowflake before cutting.)
- ❄ Two B - 2" x 6 1/2" sashing rectangles
- ❄ Two C - 2" x 9 1/2" sashing rectangles









Piece the blocks as shown. They measure 9 1/2" unfinished.

## Quilt Piecing

**\*Cut the Ornament Dot Inner Borders First!**

Cut :

- ❄ Nine D - 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" squares from Cross Stitch print for alternate blocks 
- ❄ Three E - 14" x 14" squares from Cross Stitch print for setting triangles, cut diagonally twice 
- ❄ Two F - 7 1/4" x 7 1/4" squares from Cross Stitch print for corner triangles, cut diagonally once 
- ❄ Two G - 4 3/4" x 51 1/2" strips from Ornament Dot print for inner border right and left sides\*
- ❄ Two H - 4 3/4" x 60" strips from Ornament Dot print for inner border top and bottom\*
- ❄ Fourteen I - 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" Snowflakes...centered and cut in half once diagonally 
- ❄ Six J - 9 3/4" x 9 3/4" squares from Cross Stitch print for border setting triangles, cut diagonally twice 
- ❄ Two K - 9 3/8" x 9 3/8" squares from Cross Stitch print for border corner triangles, cut diagonally once 
- ❄ Binding - cut Eight WOF x 2 1/2" strips from Rick Rack print. Piece together end to end.
- ❄ Quilt Back - 4 1/2 yards Snowman print
- ❄ Batting - 77" square



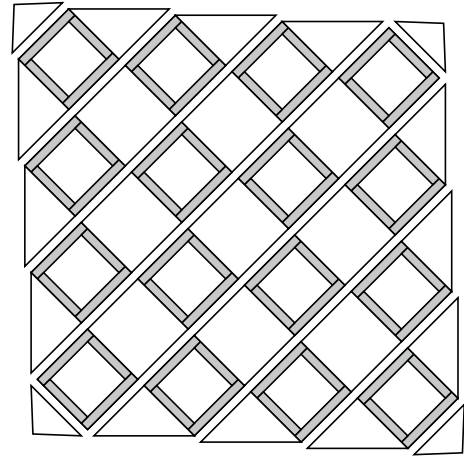
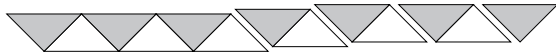
## Quilt Top Assembly

Arrange the snowflake blocks, alternate blocks **D** and setting triangles **E** in rows as shown. Sew rows together.

Add corner triangles **F**.

Add inner borders **G** & **H**.

Piece half snowflake triangles **I** with border setting triangles **J** and join together. Sew to quilt sides and top and bottom. Add corner triangles **K**.



Layer, baste & quilt. Bind and enjoy your new quilt!
